RATIONALE

The College believes that school uniform supports the inclusive ethos of the College and a strong school identity which encourages high standards and expectations in all areas of school life and associated activities.

AIMS

The Victoria College uniform

- Identifies pupils with the College
- promotes a sense of pride in the College
- engenders a feeling of community and belonging
- is practical and smart

THE ROLE OF PUPILS

Full regulation uniform should be worn throughout the school day. All pupils should wear their school blazer when Hair should be a natural shade. travelling to and from the College or when participating in any College-organised event outside school.

In extreme weather conditions, an additional plain, dark coat may be worn. These should be removed immediately on arrival at school.

THE ROLE OF PARENTS

The College seeks the support of parents in providing all of the correct uniform, ensuring it is clean and in good repair and that pupils arrive at school ready for all the activities of the day. If there are reasons, religious or other, which indicate the school uniform is inappropriate, the College will consider suitable alternatives sympathetically.

THE ROLE OF COLLEGE STAFF

Any member of staff may challenge a pupil about their appearance and will record the details of the issue as directed by agreed policy.

Persistent breaches of uniform regulations will be dealt with by the Head of Year and if breaches persist by a member of the Senior Leadership Team.

SPECIFIC UNIFORM REGULATIONS

JEWELLERY

On Health and Safety grounds the following jewellery may be worn when in uniform: a watch, one plain ring, maximum two pairs of studs (two in each ear lobe).

The following restrictions also apply:

- No other body piercing is permitted
- No piercing retainers are permitted
- Pupils will be asked to remove jewellery during PE and games

HAIR COLOUR

MAKE UP

Minimal, natural looking foundation is permitted in senior school. False eyelashes, nail polish or acrylic nails are not permitted.

OTHER ITEMS

Hoodies/sweatshirts (including VCB branded items) must not be worn with regular school uniform. The white hoodie is for PE kit only.

Pupils may wear a plain, dark coat for travelling to school which must be removed indoors.

Non-regulation jewellery/hoodies/coats will be confiscated and left in the school office for collection at the end of the school day. Breaches of the uniform policy will be recorded on SIMS as outlined in the Positive Behaviour Policy.

PE KIT

The College encourages a high level of participation in all aspects of curricular and non-curricular PE. All pupils must have their PE kit and equipment clearly labelled with their full name and form class.

For curricular PE classes, pupils must have:

- white polo shirt
- white VCB hoodie (no coloured VCB sweatshirts/fleeces)
- maroon skort worn for games with white ankle socks/white hockey socks
- training shoes suitable for impact sports (not fashion trainers)
- VCB navy blue tracksuit bottoms OR VCB navy leggings (official VCB leggings only)
- hockey stick and mouth guard
- NB: The white VCB hoodie is to be worn solely for PE classes/events and should not be worn as school uniform either under a blazer or without one.

OPTIONAL

- navy blue shorts (summer term only)
- VCB athletics vest
- white Under Armour
